**WOLVERHAMPTON
ART GALLERY**

Located in the heart of the City Centre, Wolverhampton Art Gallery was built in 1884 to house the city's art collection. This Grade II* listed building combines classic 19th century architecture with modern contemporary design to provide an exclusive and cultural venue.

Situated on the first floor, the Georgian Gallery is licenced for weddings and civil ceremonies with room for 96 guests. A spacious, light room with a magnificent glass ceiling, it houses the city's collection of 18th century paintings.

With fantastic, accessible facilities including a grand piano, distinctive locations for photographs and the option for drinks and canapés after the ceremony, Wolverhampton Art Gallery is an affordable and unique venue for your perfect ceremony.

**BANTOCK HOUSE
AND GARDENS**

Located just ten minutes' drive from the centre of Wolverhampton, Bantock House is a Grade II* listed manor house surrounded by 43 acres of beautiful parkland and delightful formal gardens.

This historic venue offers fantastic facilities including free onsite parking, amazing locations for photographs, the option for drinks and canapés after the ceremony, plus two unique locations for your special day;

Drawing Room Capacity 25 guests

Situated in the Manor House, the Edwardian drawing room is ideal for intimate ceremonies, with oak panelled walls and period furnishings.

Afternoon teas are also available in the formal dining room if holding your ceremony in the Drawing Room.

Coach House Capacity 100 guests

A large venue located in the historic outbuildings, the Coach House provides a perfect setting for couples who would like to personalise their venue.





WOLVERHAMPTON CITY ARCHIVES

Located in the heart of the city, this historic Grade II* listed Georgian building, formally the Molineux Hotel, has recently been restored to its former glory and boasts a prime location overlooking the Molineux Stadium.

Licensed for weddings and civil ceremonies, the Rococo Room is a beautiful example of classic Georgian interior design and can accommodate up to 45 guests.

With fantastic facilities including free parking, ornate formal gardens for photographs, the option for drinks and canapés after the ceremony and amazing views of the football stadium, Wolverhampton City Archives is an affordable and unique venue for your perfect ceremony.





BILSTON TOWN HALL

Bilston Town Hall is an iconic Grade II listed venue dating back to 1872 and is ideally located between Wolverhampton and Walsall in the very heart of the market town of Bilston.

This beautifully restored Victorian building offers a choice of two rooms with charming original features, including the wooden floors.

Alderman Suite Capacity 50 guests

Positioned on the ground floor, this bright and airy room with large feature windows is perfect for smaller ceremonies.

Ballroom Capacity 210 guests

Situated on the first floor and accessible by an elegant staircase or lift, the Ballroom is a wonderful, historic venue for larger ceremonies.

The Ballroom is also available for receptions and can seat up to 160 guests in a cabaret style. Couples are welcome to arrange their own decorations, caterers and entertainment, so is an ideal venue if you would like to personalise your celebrations.





WOLVERHAMPTON CIVIC CENTRE

Located in the City Centre, the Wolverhampton Civic Centre provides a smart, neutral backdrop for marriage and civil partnership with the option of two rooms for your celebrations.

The City Suite Capacity 82 guests.

Situated on the third floor of the Civic Centre, the City Suite is an affordable and elegant venue that boasts excellent accessible facilities including use of the rooftop terrace with panoramic views of the city and surrounding countryside.

The Register Office Capacity 4 guests

The Register Office provides a simple backdrop for marriage or civil partnership, and is primarily utilised by couples who wish to complete a simple legal formality before having a religious service or celebratory ceremony abroad.
